AMENDMENT

Administrative Orders PC-47, PC-186, PC-186, and PC-187

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated January 27, 1968, wherein you request an amendment to the above-captioned orders to permit the commingling of the production authorized by said orders without separately measuring the production from any pool inasmuch as all production on the respective leases is of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-47 which authorizes the commingling of Brinkard, Blinshy, and Tubb production on your Carl E. Livingston Lease is hereby amended to permit the allocation of production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-186 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Blinshy, Brinkard, Bare, and Brunson production on your Turner Lease, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-186 which authorizes the commingling of Brinkard and Blinshy production on your State Section 15 Lease is hereby amended to permit the commingling of production on the basis of periodic well tests.
