Administrative Order PC-169

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Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of March 31, 1964, wherein you request that Administrative Order PC-169 be amended to include the Tubb and Blinebry gas well liquids in the commingling authority contained therein.

Administrative Order PC-169 authorizes the commingling of Drinkard and Blinebry production on your Lockhart A-35 Lease after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method; you now propose to commingle Blinebry oil, Blinebry and Tubb gas well liquids, and Drinkard oil after separately metering the Blinebry oil and the combined Blinebry and Tubb gas well distillates, determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-169 is hereby amended to permit the aforesaid commingling in the above-described manner.
