Amendment
Administrative Order PC-171

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 31, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-171 which authorizes Shell Oil Company to commingle Glorieta and San Andres crudes on your State "T" Lease, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you now have Abo production on this lease, and that both the Abo and Glorieta are classified as intermediate type crudes and you therefore wish to commingle these crudes after separately metering and sampling the Glorieta production and determining the Abo production by means of the subtraction method. The San Andres crude would be handled separately.

Administrative Order PC-171 is hereby amended to authorize the commingling of Glorieta and Abo production on the subject State "T" Lease as described above. In all other respects Administrative Order PC-171 will remain in full force and effect.
