Reference is made to your letter of February 9, 1967, wherein you advise that all Abo production on your State "T" Lease, State "V" Lease, and State "W" Lease in the Vacuum Pool, located in Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, was to be transferred to the Vacuum Abo Unit effective February 1, 1967, and that therefore Administrative Order PC-171 which authorized the commingling of production from the Abo and Glorieta Pools on your State "T" Lease and PLC-10 which authorized the commingling of Abo production from your State "V" Lease and State "W" Lease with Glorieta production from your State "V" Lease are no longer necessary inasmuch as the Glorieta production from the State "T" Lease and State "V" Lease will be handled separately.

Administrative Orders PC-171 and PLC-10 are hereby cancelled.
