Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 5, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinney and Drinkard production on your Lockhart A-27 Lease comprising the N/2 of Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that all of the production from both of the aforesaid pools is of marginal nature.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
