Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 23, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Penrose-Skelly, Paddock, and Eunice-San Andres production from your E. O. Carson Well No. 5, E. O. Carson Well No. 11, and E. O. Carson Well No. 23, respectively, allocating the production on the basis of periodic tests. Each of the aforesaid wells is on your E. O. Carson Lease comprising the NW/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the production from each of the aforesaid three wells is of marginal nature.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid wells on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any of the aforesaid wells is capable of top allowable production.
