AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-180

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated February 18, 1964, for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-180 to include Paddock production in the commingling authority contained in said order for your Turner Lease located in Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that your Shell Turner Well No. 16 was recently converted from a shut-in Blinebry well to a marginal Paddock producer, and that you propose to commingle said Paddock production with the Drinkard and Blinebry production on said lease after separately metering the Blinebry and Paddock production and determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-180 is hereby amended to include the Paddock zone in the commingling authority contained therein; it shall in all other ways remain in full force and effect.
