A AMENDMENT
Administrative Orders PC-47, PC-100, PC-106, and PC-167

G Gentlemen:

P Reference is made to your letter dated January 27, 1968, wherein you request an amendment to the above-captioned orders to permit the commingling of the production authorized by said orders without separately measuring the production from any pool inasmuch as all production on the respective leases is of marginal nature.

V Administrative Order PC-47 which authorizes the commingling of Brinkard, Blinsbry, and Tubb production on your Carl H. Livingston Lease is hereby amended to permit the allocation of production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-100 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Blinsbry, Brinkard, Bare, and Brunson production on your Turner Lease, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-106 which authorizes the commingling of Brinkard and Blinsbry production on your State Section 15 Lease is hereby amended to permit the commingling of production on the basis of periodic well tests.
