Re: Commingling of Oil Production  
from Gutman No. 1 (Drinkard  
Oil Pool) and Gutman No. 2  
(Wantz Abo Oil Pool)

Gentlemen:

Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests an exception to Rule 303 (a) and administrative approval to commingle production from Aztec's Gutman No. 1 (Drinkard Oil Pool) and Gutman No. 2 (Wantz Abo Oil Pool) by metering the Wantz Abo production, which is expected to be top allowable, and calculating the Drinkard production, which is less than top allowable, by the subtraction method. The following facts are pertinent to this request:

1. Aztec Oil & Gas Company is the owner and operator of Gutman Well No. 1, producing from the Drinkard Oil Pool, located in Unit L, 2310' from the south line and 345' from the west line of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. Aztec Oil & Gas Company is the owner and operator of Gutman Well No. 2, dually completed in the Wantz Abo Oil Pool and the Blinbry Oil Pool, located Unit L, 1980' from the south line and 990' from the west line of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
3. The known gravities, volumes, and values of each common source of supply are herein tabulated:

4. The expected gravity of the commingled liquid hydrocarbon

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production is 40.8°. The daily value of 113 barrels with a gravity of 40.8° would be \$333.35 at \$2.95 per barrel, which is greater than the sum of the values of the production from each common source of supply.

5. A schematic diagram of the proposed installation is attached.
6. A plat showing the location of all wells on the Gutman Lease and the pool from which each well is producing is attached.





Section 11 Township 21 S Range 37 E County Lea State N.M.




●<sup>1</sup> Drinkard
