Reference is made to your letter dated September 27, 1966, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-188, which authorised the commingling of Blinebry and San Andres production on your Swigart Lease after metering the Blinebry production and determining the San Andres production by means of the subtraction method, and an amendment to Administrative Order PC-223, which authorized the commingling of Glorieta and San Andres production on your State # Lease after separately metering the Glorieta production and determining the San Andrea production by means of the subtraction method.
