Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated February 27, 1969, wherein you request authority to remove the meter from the Blinebry leg of the commingling installation authorized by Administrative Order PC-189 for your State "J" Lease in Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This order authorizes the commingling of Oil Center Blinebry and Eunice Grayburg San Andres production after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Grayburg San Andres production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that all production from both pools on said lease is of marginal nature and that you therefore propose to allocate the production on the basis of monthly well tests.

Administrative Order PC-189 is hereby amended to delete the metering requirement.
