Kershaw Lease comprising the NW/4, N/2 NE/4, and NE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Tubb production and determining the Skaggs production by means of the subtraction method.
