**Amendment**  
**Administrative Order FC-192**

**O** **Gentlemen:**

**P** **Reference is made to your letter dated August 18, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order FC-192 which authorized the commingling of Skaggs, Skaggs-Drinkard, and East Weir-Tubb production on your L. R. Kershaw Lease in Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, after separately metering the Tubb production and determining the Skaggs, Skaggs-Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that the production from all three zones is now of marginal status and that you therefore propose to commingle the production, allocating on the basis of periodic well tests.**

**Y** **Administrative Order FC-192 is hereby amended to delete the separate measurement requirement, provided, however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the three pools is capable of top allowable production.**
