
Re: Cancellation of Administrative Order PC-194

Gentlemen:

Your letter of February 27, 1964 permitted The Atlantic Refining Company to commingle Wolfcamp and Devonian production on the Dickinson A-34 Lease. The Dickinson A-34 Lease is comprised of the SE/4 NE/4 and NE/4 SE/4 of Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 37 East.
