
Re: Cancellation of Administrative Order PC-195

Gentlemen:

Your letter of February 27, 1964, permitted The Atlantic Refining Company to commingle Wolfcamp and Devonian production on the Dickinson "D" Lease in Denton Field, Lea County, New Mexico. The Dickinson "D" Lease is comprised of the E/2 W/2, SW/4 NW/4, and NW/4 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 37 East.

The Wolfcamp producing wells on this lease have been included in the Denton Wolfcamp Unit which began operating January 1, 1966. We therefore request cancellation of the commingling order PC-195.
