Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 29, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Devonian and Pennsylvania production, Moore Field, Lea County, New Mexico, from your J. L. Robinson lease comprising the W/2 of Section 23, Township 11 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Pennsylvania production and determining the Devonian production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities, including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. You are further requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that a field inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in use.
