AMENDMENT Administrative Order PC-216

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 7, 1967, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-210 to permit the inclusion of Wantz-Abo production in the commingling installation authorized for your S. J. Sarkeys Lease comprising the NW/4 of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you are currently commingling Blinebry and Drinkard production after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method; further that you wish to include the Wantz-Abo production which as well as the Blinebry production would be separately metered. The Drinkard production would continue to be determined by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-21C is hereby amended to permit the commingling as described above.
