Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 10, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Ellenburger production on your New Mex "D" Lease, comprising the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, South Brunson Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Ellenburger production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Provided further, that you shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that a field inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
