Reference is made to Administrative Order PC-214 wherein administrative approval was granted permitting the commingling of oil from the Blinebry, Brunson, Drinkard, and Hare-Simpson Pools on our L. G. Warlick "C" lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 15, T.21S, R.37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The order provided that the installation would be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities" and that Marathon would notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the above pools be capable of top allowable production.

At the time the above order was issued, L. G. Warlick "C", Well No. 3 was a shut-in Drinkard well. This well had been shut-in for several years prior to this time. Marathon wishes to advise the Commission that remedial work has been performed on L. G. Warlick "C", Well No. 3 resulting in a top allowable Drinkard Pool well.
