Administrative Order PC-214 ✓


Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated January 11, 1966, wherein you advise that your L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 3 located in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, is no longer capable of top allowable production.

Administrative Order PC-214, dated June 24, 1964, authorized the commingling of Blinebry, Brunson, Drinkard, and Simpson production on the subject lease, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests inasmuch as all production at that time was of marginal nature. Subsequently Well No. 3 was made capable of top allowable production and the production therefrom was separately metered prior to commingling.

Inasmuch as Well No. 3 is now marginal again, our letter of February 16, 1965, is rescinded and the original provisions of Administrative Order PC-214 to permit the commingling of the subject production on the basis of tests is reinstated.
