AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-218

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated September 8, 1966, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-218 which authorized the commingling of Paddock, Penrose-Skelly, and Drinkard production on your Grizzell Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that your Grizzell Well No. 6 has recently been dually completed as a Drinkard oil and Blinebry gas producer and that you wish Administrative Order PC-218 amended to provide that the condensate produced from the Blinebry Gas Pool could be included in the commingling installation. Further, that allocation of production from each well will continue to be made on the basis of monthly well tests inasmuch as all oil wells on said lease are still of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-218 is hereby amended to include the condensate from the Blinebry Gas Pool on the Grizzell Lease.
