Reference order was approved August 3, 1961, for commingling Glorieta and the production on our "C" well "A" lease comprising the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 33, Township 17 N., Range 35 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

We hereby request cancellation of order PC-221. This order is no longer required by Tidewater Oil Company since authority to commingle production from the above mentioned pools is not necessary. The Abo production has been transferred to the Vacuum Abo Unit, operated by Phillips Petroleum Company, effective February 1, 1967. The Glorieta production will be handled separately.
