Gentlemen:

Please refer to Administrative Orders PC-188 and PC-223 granting Shell Oil Company permission to commingle Vacuum Glorieta and Vacuum San Andres production on cur Swigart and State H leases, respectively. Glorieta production is currently being metered and sampled while San Andres production is determined by the subtraction method.

In order to facilitate production handling on these leases and decrease the time requirements of our field personnel, we request permission to commingle production while metering and sampling San Andres production and determining Glorieta production by subtraction. Production facilities will remain as specified in our original applications, with the exception that flowlines will be interchanged in order to change the metered production. Since both Glorieta and San Andres production are sour and have a similar gravity range, no change in revenue is anticipated.

We hereby request amendments to PC-188 and PC-223 granting Shell permission to interchange metering facilities on the aforementioned leases. If further information is required, please contact this office.
