Administrative Order IC-226

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 12, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Vacuum-Glorieta, North Vacuum-Abo, Vacuum-Wolfcamp, and Vacuum-Upper Pennsylvanian production on your State Leased Lease comprising the NE/4 SW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Glorieta, Abo, and Upper Pennsylvanian production and determining the Wolfcamp production by means of the subtraction method. Administrative Order IC-226 authorized the commingling of all of the aforesaid production with the exception of the Upper Pennsylvanian.

Administrative Order IC-226 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the four aforesaid zones in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the modification of the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
