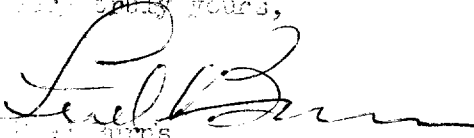
Sinclair Oil & Gas Company hereby makes application to Statewide Rule 303 to permit commingling of oil produced from the Drinkard and Blinebry Oil Pools on the A. T. Gore "A" Lease, 1/2 of the SW/4 of Section 26, T21S, R37E, 1st County, New Mexico. Well No. 1 is to be recompleted as a Blinebry Oil-Drinkard oil-well. The Blinebry is expected to produce top allowable and the Drinkard is expected to produce top allowable for a short period of time.

It is requested that administrative approval be granted to commingle the oil from the Blinebry Oil Well with the oil from the Drinkard Pool by metering the Blinebry Oil and using the subtraction method to determine the oil production from the Drinkard Pool. The individual well production from each Pool is proposed to be as provided in periodic well tests as required by the Commission. Well tests to be accomplished by shutting in one well while testing the other.

The gravity of the Blinebry oil is 35° API and is valued at \$2.99 per barrel. The Drinkard oil is 31° API gravity and is valued at \$3.01 per barrel. The gravity of the commingled oil is expected to be 39.6° API with a resulting value of \$3.00 per barrel.

An early approval of this application would be appreciated.
