Administrative Order CTB-110

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of October 6, 1964, requesting cancellation of Administrative Order CTB-110 which authorizes the commingling of Devonian production from your State 4011 Lease and your State Lea 403 Lease after separately measuring the Devonian production from each lease, and also authorizes the commingling of Bone Spring production from each lease after separately measuring the same. Your present proposal is to commingle the North Vacuum Devonian and the Vacuum Abe production on the State Lea 403 Lease without separately measuring the production from each pool and to commingle the North Vacuum Devonian and the Vacuum Abe production on the State 4011 Lease without separately measuring the production from each pool. It is our understanding that all of the wells on the subject leases are physically incapable of producing top allowable.

Administrative Order CTB-110 is hereby cancelled, and, by the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said leases in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well connected to either of the aforesaid commingling installations is capable of top allowable production.
