AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-243

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 29, 1966, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-243 which authorized the commingling of Skaggs, Skaggs-Drinkard, and East Weir-Blinebry production on that portion of your M. B. Weir "B" Lease located in the S/2 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the Skaggs and East Weir-Blinebry Pools and determining the production from the Skaggs-Drinkard Pool by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that all of the production on this lease is now of marginal nature and that you wish to commingle said production without separate measurement, allocating the production to each of the pools on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-243 is hereby amended to delete the metering requirement, provided however, that you shall notify the Commission if any well in any of the aforesaid pools becomes capable of top allowable production.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 1, 1966, in which you request an amendment to Administrative Order 10-145, which authorized the commencing of the production of oil from the wells located in the SW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 1N, Range 1E, East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separate measurements of production from the 28-acre and East 1/4-1/4-acre sections of the production from the 28-acre section and the 1/4-1/4-acre section method.

It is our understanding that all of the wells in the 28-acre section are now of marginal value and that you are desiring to continue production without separate measurements, all of the wells in the 1/4-1/4-acre section of the 28-acre section.

Administrative Order 10-145 is hereby amended to provide for the making of separate measurements, provided however, that the Commission is not well in any of the 28-acre section of the 1/4-1/4-acre section of the 28-acre section.
