Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated October 6, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinsbry oil and Tubb distillate production on your A. H. Blinsbry (NCT-1) Lease comprising the NE/4 of Section 19 and the S/2 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that although all of the working interests are common throughout the aforesaid lease, the royalty ownership is not identical, and that you therefore propose to separately measure the Blinsbry oil production from the NE/4 of Section 19 and the Tubb distillate and Blinsbry oil production from the S/2 of Section 20 prior to commingling the same. The liquid hydrocarbon production will be measured with positive displacement meters equipped with non-reset counters, temperature compensators, strainers, air and gas eliminators and fluid samplers, all of the approved kind.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
