Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 24, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard oil and Tubb distillate on your S. E. Cone Lease comprising the N/2 SE/4 of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry and Drinkard production and determining the Tubb distillate production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
