Dear Sir:

Texas Pacific Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval of exception under Rule 313 "Integration of Production From Pools" to permit the commingling of production on the captioned lease.

In support of this request, the following information is presented for your consideration:

1. The J. E. Cera Lease contains 40 acres being the 1/2, SW/4 Section 26, T-21-S; R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. Ownership of all zones is identical.
3. The commercial value of the commingled production will be the same or greater than the sum of the values of the production from each of the separate zones.
4. The commingling facilities will utilize the subtraction method and will be in accordance with applicable provisions of the Oil Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
5. At present this lease contains Well No. 1 which is a Blinbry Oil, Brinkard Oil and Tubb Gas; Well No. 2 is a Brinkard Oil; and Well No. 4 was recently completed in Wantz Abo Oil and Blinbry Oil. Any additional wells on the lease completed in these zones will be added to the proposed commingling system.

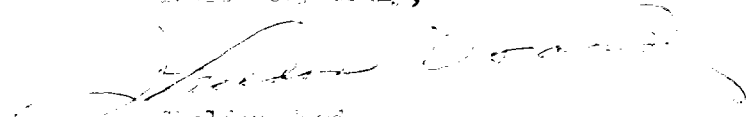

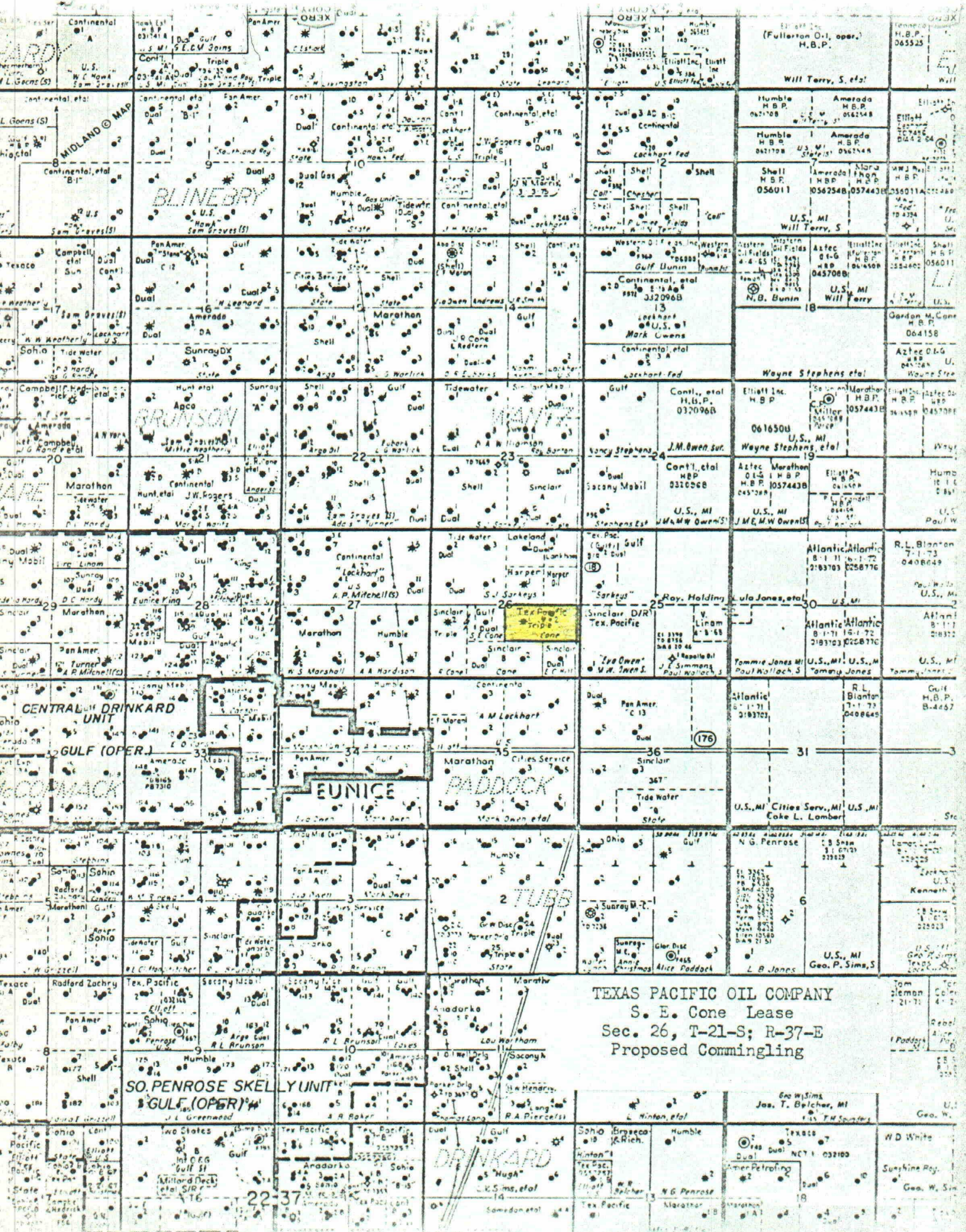
4. Attached is a schematic diagram of the proposed commingling system and a plot of its design.
5. The expected average gasifier are: Elineberg 36°, Takt 72°, Delmar 39°, and White Rock 41.6°.

Approval was granted by Bureau No. PC-217 on 12-7-64 for commingling of Elineberg and Delmar oil and White Rock distillate.

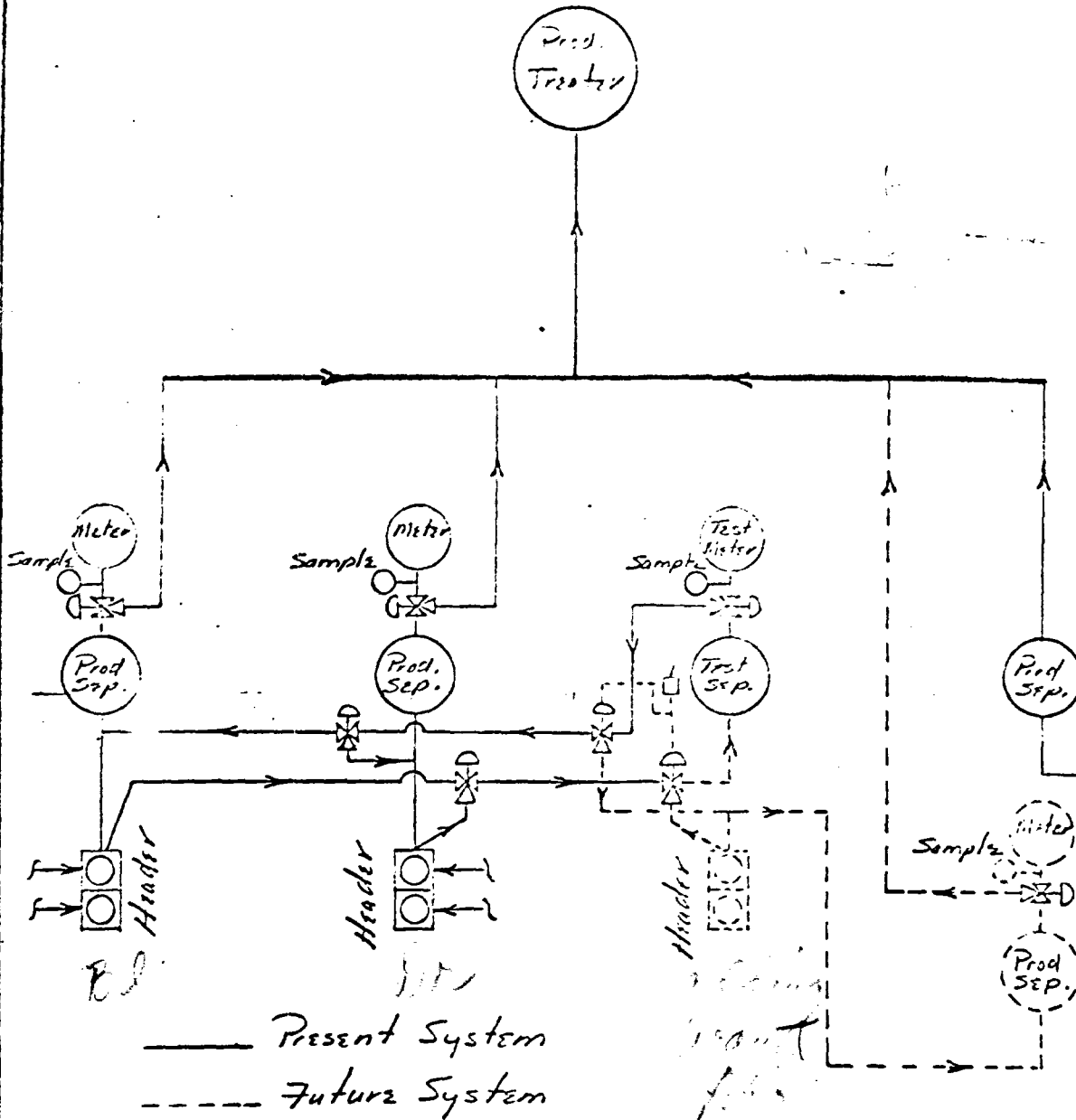
