Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 3, 1964, for administrative approval of an exemption to Rule 303 (c) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Shark Gasbury and Undesignated Tubb production on your Southeast Monument Unit in Townships 70 South, Range 37 East and 20 South, Range 38 East, Los County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Tubb production and determining the Gasbury production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Robbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
