
Description: Portions of Sections 13, 14, and 24, T-20-S,
R-37-E and portions of Sections 18, 19, and
30, T-20-S, R-38-E, NMPM, Lea County, N.M.

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Skaggs Grayburg, Undesignated Paddock, Blinebry Oil and Gas, Monument Tubb, and Skaggs Drinkard pool production in a common tank battery and production will be determined by separately metering the Undesignated Paddock pool production. The production from Well Nos. 83 (Monument Tubb) and 21 (downhole commingled Blinebry Oil and Gas and Skaggs Drinkard) shall also be metered separately and the production from the Skaggs Grayburg pool shall be determined by the subtraction method.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The original Commingling Order PC 250 permitted surface commingling of Skaggs Grayburg and Undesignated Tubb production. This was amended to allow surface commingling of Undesignated Blinebry production. These pools have since been designated as Monument Tubb and Blinebry Oil and Gas, respectively. Furthermore, Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-4913 permitted downhole commingling of the Blinebry Oil and Gas and Skaggs Drinkard zones in S.E.M.U. Well No. 21.
