Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated March 2, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Goodwin Abo and Goodwin production on your State GG-30 Lease comprising the SW/4 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.

Administrative Order PLC-7, dated January 17, 1964, authorized the commingling of Goodwin Abo and Goodwin production from your Goodwin "30" and State GG-30 Leases, after separately metering the production from each zone and from each lease prior to commingling. We assume from the instant application that your Goodwin "30" Lease is not being commingled with the GG-30 production. Please advise as to the status of the Goodwin "30" Lease production.
