Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PC-255 granted Continental Oil Company authority to commingle production on our State GG-30, Lea County, New Mexico from the Goodwin Abo and Goodwin Drinkard pools, provided production from both of the pools be metered. At the time Administrative Order PC-255 was granted some of the wells in each of the pools on the State GG-30 Lease were top allowable. The following tabulation of production from the State GG-30 Lease shows none of the wells are top allowable and the tests listed indicate they are not capable of producing top allowable. Therefore, Continental Oil Company respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-255 be amended to eliminate the necessity of metering production from the individual pools on the State GG-30 Lease. Production will be allocated to each pool and well based on current Gas-Oil Ratio Surveys.
