Re: Amendment to Administrative
Order PC-261

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your request for the amendment to Administrative Order PC-261 which at present authorizes the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production from your State "367" lease, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Drinkard production and determining the Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that you wish the order amended not only to delete the metering requirement inasmuch as all production on the said lease is of marginal nature but to also include condensate from the Tubb and Blinebry gas pools in the commingling installation. This condensate production is at present being commingled under authority of Commission Order No. R-464.

Inasmuch as ownership of all production is identical throughout and such production is all of marginal nature, Administrative Order PC-261 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Blinebry oil, Drinkard oil, Blinebry condensate and Tubb condensate allocating on the basis of periodic well tests.

Commission Order R-464 which previously authorized commingling as described above is hereby put in abeyance.

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It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the purchaser of this commingling authority.
