Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your application dated May 6, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Tubb Drinkard production on your J. A. Stuart Lease comprising the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 11, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Justis Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the top Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
