Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 7, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Drinkard and Blinebry production on your State "B" Lease which comprises the SE/4 of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

By letter of October 26, 1965, you submitted a tabulation of production indicating that the Blinebry zone has continuously declined and is indeed marginal as is the Drinkard. We can, therefore, now approve your proposed commingling installation without the requirement of separate measurement of the production prior to commingling.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided, further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 7, 1935, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 308 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the company of Baker and Blasing production on your State Oil Lease which comprises the 27 1/2 of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 17 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic oil tests.

By letter of October 28, 1935, you submitted a calculation of production indicating that the Blasing zone has continuously declined and is indeed marginal as is the Driskard. As can, therefore, not support your proposed continuing installation without the payment of a certain measurement of the production prior to commencing.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 308 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to continue the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission Rules for the installation and operation of commencing facilities, and provided, further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any pool either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top capable production.
