Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 20, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Nonombre-Upper Pennsylvanian and Nonombre-Lower Pennsylvanian production on your State "D" Lease comprising the N/2 of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Lower Pennsylvanian production and determining the Upper Pennsylvanian production by means of the subtraction method. The Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico on August 23, 1966, approved this application.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
