Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated September 27, 1966, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Drinkard and Penrose-Skelly production on your W. H. Turner Lease comprising the N/2 SW/4 of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that the production from each pool is of marginal nature.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner.
