Gentlemen:

Your letter of December 6 requests approval to commingle the liquid hydrocarbons produced from the Mesaverde and Dakota formations in well No. 5 Culpepper-Martin in common surface facilities. Such well, in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 22, T. 32 N., R. 12 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, is located on fee land which is communitized with lease Santa Fe 078312 under communitization agreement No. I-Sec.-No. 860 to comprise a 320-acre spacing unit.

The method proposed for surface commingling of the liquid hydrocarbons produced from well No. 5 Culpepper-Martin and the allocation of such liquids to each formation on the basis of the annual gas-oil ratio tests is hereby approved. Form 9-361, Lessee's Monthly Report of Sales and Royalty, must show all computations used in the allocation of the commingled liquid production to each formation.

Please notify our Farmington office when the installation of these facilities has been completed.
