**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your application dated October 24, 1967, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota condensate produced from your Federal Well No. 16 located in Unit M of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of semiannual gas-liquid ratio tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools in said well in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
