**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your application dated November 21, 1967, for an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Tapacito-Gallup and South Blanco-Tocito production on your Breech "C" Lease, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Specifically, the request is to commingle Tapacito-Gallup production from your Well No. 248, located in Section 13, with South Blanco-Tocito production from your Wells Nos. 140, 144, and 689, located in Sections 11 and 12. It is our understanding that Commission Order No. R-532 authorized commingling of this production but due to the recent reclassification of Well No. 248 it is no longer in the South Blanco-Tocito Pool but is now in the Tapacito-Gallup Associated Oil Pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, allocating the production to each on the basis of periodic tests. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of
