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Gentlemen:

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Reference is made to your application dated April 26, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of undesignated Wolfcamp condensate production and undesignated Devonian oil production from your Southeast Lea Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit J of Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

We have now received the consent of the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico to the proposed commingling.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of it.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE COMMISSION

Dear Sirs:

Reference is made to your application dated April 2, 1964, for a certificate of approval of an operation in Rule 70 (a) of the Rules on Rules and Regulations to permit the installation of a new oil production well in your Township, Range 12 North, East 1/4 of Section 22, Township 22 North, Range 12 North, New Mexico, as a separate well in the existing well.
