The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Penrose Skelly (Grayburg) and Drinkard pool production in a common tank battery and to determine the production from each pool by well tests. (If this method is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of marginal nature; further, the operator shall notify the Santa Fe Office of the Division in the event any well in the commingled battery becomes capable of top allowable production, at which time the Division will amend this order or take such other action as may be appropriate.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

Gas from each of the wells on the lease is to be separately metered.

REMARKS: Amended Administrative Order PC-356, dated December 2, 1968, authorized the commingling of Blinebry and Penrose Skelly production from the above lease. This amended order authorizes the commingling of production from the Penrose Skelly and Drinkard Pools.
