AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-363

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your request for the amendment of Administrative Order PC-363, which authorized the commingling of Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres oil and Morrow condensate on your Lea Lease in Sections 29 and 30, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Morrow production and determining the Grayburg-San Andres production by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that Well No. 23, the only Morrow well on the lease, has now been recompleted as a Wolfcamp oil producer, and you wish to commingle this Wolfcamp production with the Grayburg-San Andres production after separately metering the Wolfcamp production.

Administrative Order PC-363 is hereby amended as described above, provided that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
