O Gentlemen:

D Reference is made to your application dated September 30, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of D-K Abo and D-K Drinkard production from your Federal 12-30 Lease comprising the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 30, Township 20 South, Range 39 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that the production from both pools on said lease is of marginal nature.

V By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
