Gentlemen:

We respectfully request an exception to Rule 303(a) to allow us to commingle oil production and separately casinghead gas production on our C. D. Woolworth lease in the Jalmat and Langlie Mattix Fields. Production in the Jalmat is from Wells Nos. 8 and 14. Production from the Langlie Mattix is from Well No. 7. Production summaries are:

	<u>September</u>	<u>October</u>	<u>Average Gravity</u>	<u>Average Value/Barrel</u>
Jalmat: Well No. 8	356	371	28	\$2.78
Well No. 14	425	344	28	\$2.78
Langlie Mattix: Well No. 7	439	556	28	\$2.78

This production is marginal from all wells. There will be no change in the oil values due to commingling.

Since production from all wells is marginal, we propose to allocate oil and casinghead gas production to each well based on periodic individual well tests. Our proposed commingling facility (see attached sketch) provides for such testing.

Royalty and working interests are common.

We also enclose a lease plat which reflects the C. D. Woolworth lease and the affected wells.

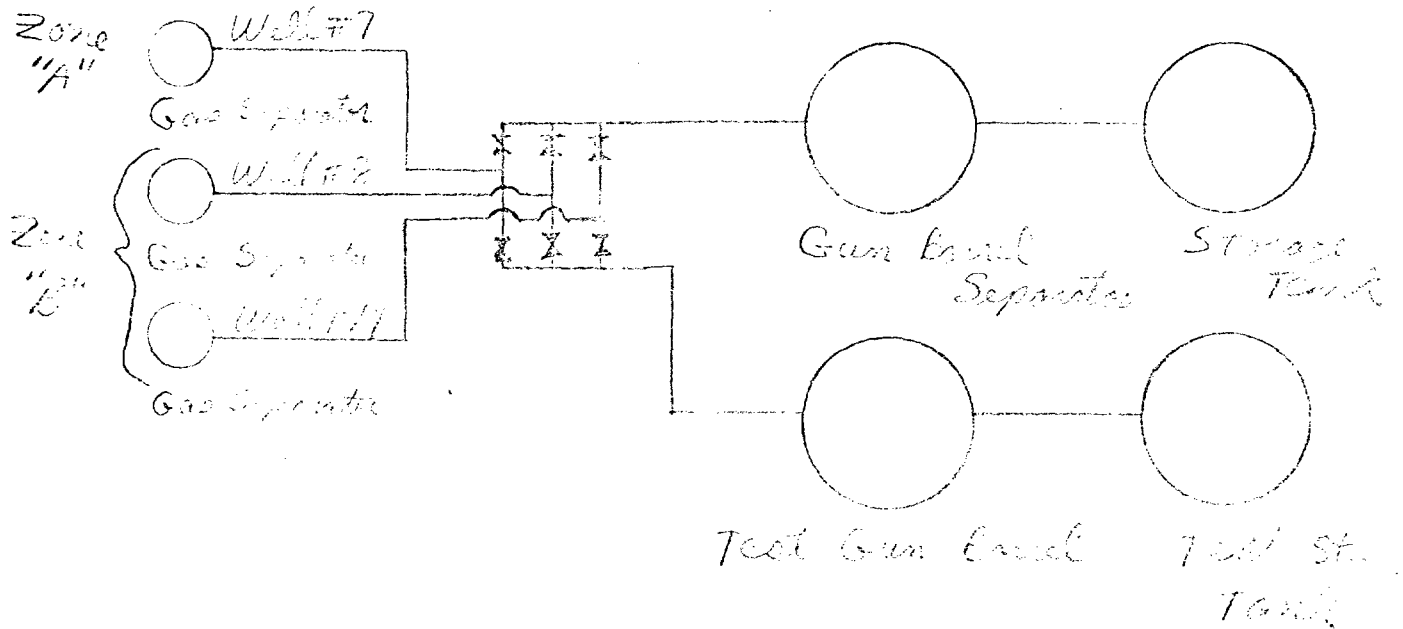
