AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-375

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Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 11, 1969, for the amendment of Administrative Order PC-375, which order authorized the commingling of Blinebry and San Andres production from your State "A" Lease comprising the S/2 NE/4 of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, Hobbs Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry oil and determining the San Andres production by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that you now wish to add Drinkard production from your State "A" Lease to the commingling installation and that the Blinebry and Drinkard production would be separately metered and the San Andres production would continue to be determined by means of the subtraction method.

Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Administrative Order PC-375 is hereby amended as described above, provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters, and provided further, that you shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the revision of this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made thereof.

AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-37

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 11, 1964, for the amendment of Administrative Order PC-37, which order authorized the commingling of Blinberry and San Andres production from your lease containing the S/N 224 of Section 32, Township 14 South, Range 36 East, Hobbs Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metered the Blinberry oil and determining the San Andres production by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that you now wish to add Blinberry production from your State A lease to the commingling installation and that the Blinberry and Blinberry production would be separately metered and the San Andres production would continue to be determined by means of the subtraction method.

Inasmuch as the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 12.1 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, to amend Administrative Order PC-37 is hereby amended as described above, provided, however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters, and provided further, that you shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the revision of said installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made thereof.
