Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 2, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Wantz-Abo and Drinkard production from your W. S. Marshall "B" Lease comprising the SW/4 of Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that all production from the aforesaid pools on said lease is of marginal nature.
