Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 18, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Nonombre-Upper Pennsylvanian, Nonombre-Lower Pennsylvanian, and Nonombre-Middle Pennsylvanian production from your State "D" Lease comprising the N/2 of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of quarterly well tests. It is our understanding that all production from the aforesaid pools on said lease is of marginal nature.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
